Renewable Energy Directive from Chairman Skrmetta

I direct utilities to include as a line item on utility bills for any and all costs collected from ratepayers as a result of the Commission's Renewable Energy Pilot Program in Docket No. R-28271 Subdocket B.

Energy Efficiency Directive from Chairman Skrmetta

I hereby direct Staff to review our Energy Efficiency rules and report back to the Commission as soon as possible on whether there are additional ratepayer protections that should be implemented to allow full Commission oversight and audit capability of any non-jurisdictional entity receiving funding as a result of the Commission's Energy Efficiency Rules.
