**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

The Louisiana Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued a citation to LeBlanc's Towing & Recovery, LLC of Broussard, Louisiana (the "Carrier"), on July 10, 2018, directing the Carrier to appear at a hearing on August 23, 2018, to show cause why its Common Carrier Certificate Number 7959 should not be cancelled due to the Carrier's failure to file an Annual Report for 2017 and/or why the Carrier should not be ordered to pay a late filing fee of \$500 and a citation fee of \$25 as required by the Commission's General Order 2 dated July 21, 1921 and the Commission's General Order dated April 23, 2001, as amended June 19, 2012. Notice of the proceeding was published in the Commission's Official Bulletin on July 13, 2018. On August 3, 2018, the Commission Staff filed a Motion to Dismiss, advising that all issues have been resolved and requesting that the proceeding be dismissed with prejudice.

This dismissal is prepared in accordance with Rule 56(d) of the Rules of Practice and Procedures of the Louisiana Public Service Commission, which provides:

*Except at the discretion of the administrative law judge, the procedures contained within subpart (a) of this Rule shall not apply to a motion to dismiss jointly filed by all parties of record, a motion to dismiss with prejudice filed by the party who instituted the proceeding, or a motion to dismiss without prejudice filed by a party who instituted the proceeding but prior to the filing of any other party's filing of a responsive pleading. Upon the filing of such a motion to dismiss, the administrative law judge may forego all recommendation procedures and prepare an appropriate order of dismissal for issuance by the Commission.*

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That Docket Number T-34915 be, and hereby is, DISMISSED with prejudice.
