**REPORT OF STATUS CONFERENCE**

A status conference was convened in this proceeding on May 10, 2016, before Administrative Law Judge Joy Guillot. Participating in the status conference were: Kara Kantrow, via telephone, on behalf of Service International of SWLA, LLC (“Carrier” or “Applicant”); William Kirtland on behalf of Intervenor Roy Bailey Construction, Inc., Stranco, LLC and Stafford Transport of Louisiana, Inc., D/B/A CEI; and Ann Hill on behalf of the Louisiana Public Service Commission (“Commission”) Staff. No one appeared on behalf of Intervenor Scioneaux, LLC.

Ms. Kantrow provided an overview of the Carrier’s application for a Common Carrier Certificate, authorizing the Carrier to transport non-hazardous oilfield waste, non-hazardous industrial solid waste and hazardous waste for disposal, statewide. After a brief discussion, the parties agreed to a procedural schedule.

***PLEASE TAKE NOTICE*** that the following procedural schedule is hereby established:

August 31, 2016

- 1) By this date, Commission Staff shall file notice of any complaint, citation, or **violation pending** against the Applicant.
- 2) If the proceeding remains **contested** as of this date, a Pre-hearing Statement shall be due from any party intending to present testimony and evidence at hearing, other than for purposes of impeachment or rebuttal. The Statement shall include:
  - List of the party’s witnesses, including a statement of whether the testimony of each witness will be presented in person at the hearing or in written form (affidavit or deposition)
  - List of the party’s exhibits
  - The estimated amount of time the party will need to present its case
- 3) If the proceeding is **uncontested** as of this date, the Applicant shall file a status update, together with a copy of Restrictive Amendments reflecting the withdrawal of all opposition to the application.

4) Any party seeking a **continuance** of the hearing date must file a motion for the continuance by this date. The motion must also contain a statement (1) affirming that the moving party has contacted all other parties to the case concerning the proposed continuance and (2) advising of the position of each of the other parties to the proposed continuance. Motions for continuance filed after this date will be considered only upon a showing of good cause for the delay.


**September 7 & 9, 2016 Hearing.** A hearing in this matter will be convened at **10:00 A.M. on Wednesday, September 7, 2016** and continue as needed on Friday, September 9, 2016 in the 11<sup>th</sup> Floor Hearing Room of the Galvez Building, 602 North Fifth Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

All parties intending to present evidence at the hearing should bring a copy of each exhibit for the court reporter, as well as additional copies for the judge, the research attorney, and all other parties to the proceeding.

At the hearing, the applicant will have the burden of proving public convenience and necessity by demonstrating a public need for the applicant's service and that the grant of authority is in the public interest. In addition to proving public convenience and necessity the applicant shall provide proof of its fitness to operate. Parties protesting the application may offer evidence that the proposed grant of authority will have a substantial and detrimental impact upon its capital investment.<sup>1</sup>
